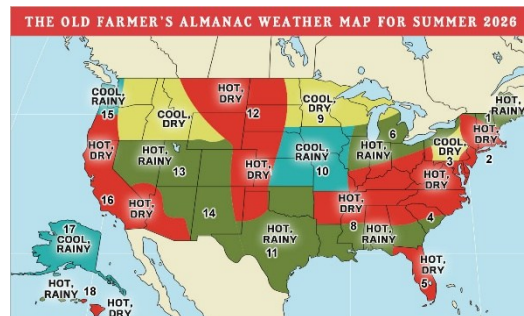

Surprising information for most people...

Most vehicles today have fuel pumps located inside the tank, one very important aspect to that, believe it or not, it is intended for the **fuel in the tank to help keep the pump cool during operation**.

When the fuel level gets to a low point and the fuel is not cooling it, the **pump overheats** and over time this will **cause it to fail**. In the past, we would often see this in cars driven by teens because many don't have enough money to keep the fuel level up in their cars.

We see a jump in **fuel pump failures** when the price of **gas goes higher**. Replacing many fuel pumps is **very expensive**. It is not uncommon to see prices that are in the **\$500-\$1500** range and higher on some models.
